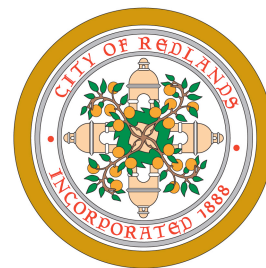


City of Redlands Speakers Bureau
